FAMA Sloping Tray: a sloping tray which can be pulled out for filling. Medicines are picked with the tray closed.

FAMA Drawer: a pharmacy drawer for the well-ordered storage of various medicines, as well as anything that needs to be stored free of dust. Dividers keep different items separate and double-height drawers can be used for storing large packages and containers.



FAMA Flat Shelf: these flat shelves are the ideal place to store excess stock and large containers or packages. Used in the upper shelf area they are particularly well suited for keeping office supplies such as folders.
